# Southwest Michigan Seek \& Search Club By-Laws 

(Current 12-01-2021)

## Article VII - Voting

Section A - Quorum
$\mathbf{2 5 \%}$ of the current membership shall constitute a "Quorum".
Section B - Motions
Any motion put before the membership or a general meeting, being properly seconded, must be voted on unless withdrawn. A simple majority shall decide its acceptance. A show of hands shall suffice unless a secret ballot is requested.

Section C - Eligibility

1. Because we have family and individual memberships, there shall be only one vote per paid membership (i.e. only one person may vote with a family membership) tor policy issues.
2. Members must be $\mathbf{1 8}$ or older to vote on policy issues.
3. All members/family members may vote on Find Of the Month items, regardless of age.

## Article VIII - Amendment to the Rules

These By-laws may be amended only after the proposed amendment has been presented at a prior general meeting. Any change in By-Laws requires a vote of a quorum of the membership present and two-thirds majority of those voting.

Note: Nominations for club (board) officers will be at May meeting (per by-laws below).
Article IV - Board:
Section A - Elections

Elections for all Board positions shall be held every two years at the June meeting.
Section B - Terms

Officers and Trustees shall serve two-year terms. No Member shall hold more than one Board position at any one time.

Note: Existing officers will signify if they wish to run again for this next 2 year cycle, nominations for positions being vacated or to run against incubants will also be taken at this time. Voting will be held at the next (June) meeting. Board positions are as follows: President, Vice President, Treasurer, Secretary, and Trustees (3 main, and 1 alternate).
